Subject: - State definition of Drop-out.

Like most of the States of the Country, Tripura has also been facing the challenge of the phenomenon of Drop Out in the Education System. This critical problem stands in the way of achieving the goal of universalization of Elementary Education. Due to constant all out efforts, dropout rate in the State has drastically reduced. Despite of that due to some critical factors a few number of children are dropping out of schooling system and the phenomenon still prevails.

In order to address the problem more strategically it has been felt necessary to define the phenomenon of Drop Out in the context of the State.

Accordingly, it has now been decided that if any child after being admitted in a School leaves it without completing his/her Elementary Education or leaves after failing in any examination, shall be treated as **Dropped-out.**

This shall have immediate effect.
