NOTIFICATION

Subject: Per Child cost for reimbursement of expenditure to the children belonging to Disadvantaged Group and Weaker Section enrolled in Private Unaided Schools under RTE Act, 2009.


Under Section 12(I)(c) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, all Private Un-aided schools (recognized), as specified under sub-clause (iv) of clause (n) of Section 2, shall admit in Class I/Pre-School Section, to the extent of at least twenty five percent of the strength of that class, children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.

Under section 12(2), all Private Un-aided schools (recognized), shall be reimbursed amount of expenditure so incurred by it to the extent of per child expenditure as notified by the State Government.

Now in order to implement the provision of the RTE Act 2009 as aforesaid, it is notified that maximum per child cost shall be **Rs.21,138/-** per annum for reimbursement of expenditure to the private unaided schools (recognized) admitting children belonging to Weaker Section and Disadvantaged Group. The reimbursement shall be made to such private schools on the basis of the notified per child cost or the actual amount charged from the children whichever is less.

Following shall be the procedure for reimbursement:-

- i. Under Section 12 (b) (I) of the State RTE Rules 2011, all private unaided schools (recognized) claiming reimbursement of expenditure as aforesaid, shall notify at the commencement of each Academic Year and on completion of its admission process, the number of students in the school against whom the school is entitled to claim reimbursement.
- ii. The District Education Officers of the concerned Districts shall reimburse the amount of expenditure as considered eligible on the basis of monthly statements to be submitted by the schools.
