**M E M O**

Subject :- Private tuition by the school teachers of the Govt. Schools and the Govt.- Aided Schools – instructions regarding.

It is observed that some teachers of the Govt. Schools and the Govt. Aided Schools engage themselves in private tuition or private teaching activity thereby resorting to earning money though the practice of private tuition or private teaching activity has been prohibited vide instructions issued from time to time from this end.

Such practice goes against the relevant provisions of the Service Conduct Rules in force since the teachers of the Govt. Schools and the Govt.- Aided Schools are within the ambit of the said rules.


The teachers are aware that their position in the society is looked upon with a sense of respect and it is expected that they would not fail in discharging their responsibility by imparting education through regular schooling in an effective manner. It is also expected that they would not do anything which may go to tarnish their image built in the eyes of the society.

It is a matter of great regret when some teachers are reported to have been awfully busy with private tuition showing thumb to the instructions of the higher authorities. This is a painful state of affairs.

All concerned should understand that the practice of private tuition hurts those students aspiring for learning through regular schooling since the teachers concerned fail to devote their full energy in class works because their energy gets exhausted while practising private tuition for money at homes.

Of late, Govt. of India under Ministry of Law and Justice ( Legislative Department ) has notified " The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 ( 35 of 2009 ) " with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010, applicable through out Republic of India except Jammu & Kashmir. Private tuition has been prohibited vide clause No. 28 of chapter IV of the said Act.

It is, therefore, reiterated that if any teacher is found involved in private tuition for money, appropriate administrative measures will be taken against such teacher. The contents of the memo should be brought to the notice of all teachers so as to sensitize them about the consequence of private tuition.
